All students are required to purchase the pattern, "*Hibiscus*" for class.

Quilt top to be completed *and quilted* in class.

Fabric Requirements: bring all fabrics...top, backing and batting

What to Bring To The Class:

Fabrics and batting as needed to complete the wall hanging quilt

Freezer Paper

Chalk Pencil

Small paper-cutting scissors

Fabric glue stick or Roxanne's Glue Baste

Threads to match or contrast your choice of fabric for quilting the flower.

Quilt Basting Pins

(sorry, but due to allergies, no basting sprays will be allowed in class.)

Other Supplies to bring to Class:

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic sewing supplies, scissors, pins

Rotary cutter

Square ruler 12.5" x 12.5" or larger

Darning foot (for free-motion machine quilting)

Extra Needles

Quilting gloves or *Lickety Grip* are highly recommended

The fabric requirements listed below are for the Wall Hanging and Decorative Pillow pictured on the front of this pattern. Fabric requirements are based on 42" wide fabrics and a standard 1/4" seam allowance is included in all measurements.

Please read entire directions before starting.

Wall Hanging
(Finished Size: 34" x 34")

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 1/4 yards Background/Outer Border Fabric
- 1 yard tone-on-tone Hibiscus Fabric
(allows for some "placement possibilities")
- 1/8 yard Inner Border Fabric
- 7" x 7" Flower Center Fabric
- 5" x 5" Yellow Fabric for Flower Stamen
- 1 yard Backing Fabric
- 3/8 yard Binding Fabric
- 36" x 36" Batting

Decorative Pillow
(Finished Size: 19.5" x 19.5")

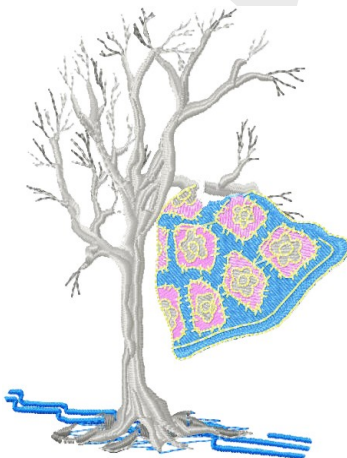
Fabric Requirements:

- 1 Fat Quarter Background Fabric
- 1 Fat Quarter Flower Fabric
- 1/8 yard Inner Border Fabric
- 1/4 Outer Border Fabric
- 5/8 Pillow Back Fabric
- 4" x 4" Flower Center Fabric
- 3" x 3" Yellow Fabric for Flower Stamen
- 15" x 15" Batting for Quilting Pillow Center
- 15" x 15" Backing for Quilting Pillow Center

20" Pillow Form

Other Supplies That May Be Helpful Include:

- Roxanne's Glue Baste (Raw-Edge Appliqué Technique)
- 2 yards Fusible Web (Fusible Appliqué Technique)
- Plastic Template Material
- Freezer Paper
- Chalk Pencil
