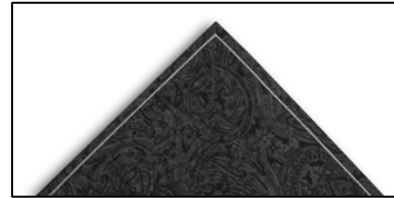

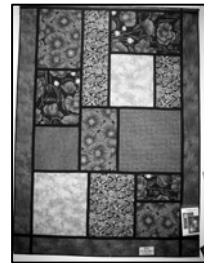

Introducing free motion quilting in 1984, Harriet became the fairy godmother of machine quilting! This is her favorite class to teach and, due to the amount of information included, she will only teach it in a 2-day format. Machine quilting techniques that will turn quilt tops into heirlooms in a fraction of the time it takes to hand quilt will be taught. A thorough discussion of preparing the quilt top for quilting, work space suggestions, threads, needles, etc. will be covered. Hands-on exercises will be done to develop various quilting skills, from walking foot to ditch quilting to free motion feathers. Harriet is a master at teaching beginners... if you are one, don't miss this opportunity! (Classroom change on Saturday.)
